Inclusion & Recognition

+ Maths Mastery Success

In January 2024, we introduced the White Rose Maths Mastery scheme, with two staff members appointed as Maths Champions to lead its implementation. We are delighted to share that this initiative has had a remarkable impact our children completed the year with the **highest maths outcomes** we've ever recorded!

A Curriculum Enrichment

We expanded forest school sessions, increased local visits, and launched intergenerational partnerships with Woolton Acre Retirement Home and St Hugh's reading buddy scheme.
